

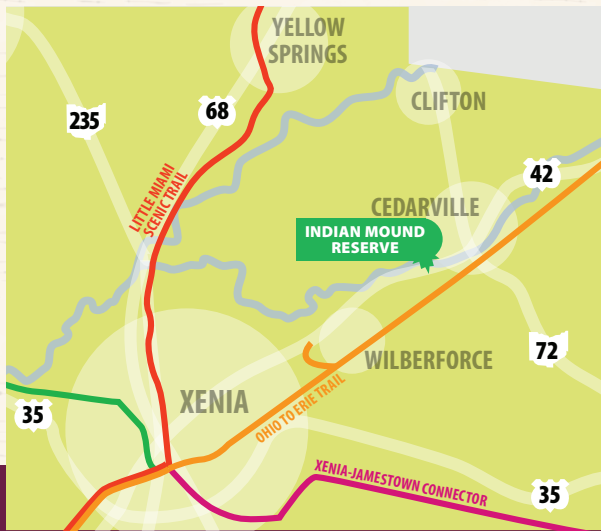
## Indian Mound Reserve

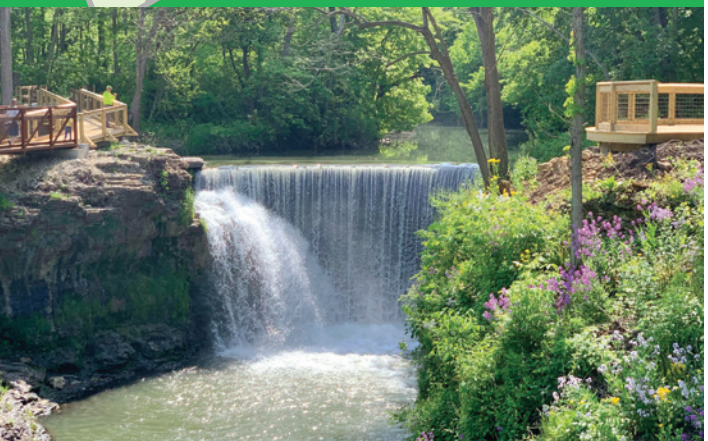
