Special Projects Manager Charles Frazier updated the Board on the current special projects within the park system.

### 1. Creekside Trail:

- James Ranch Bridge deck. Contractor is finishing the cleaning of bridge.
  Decking is in place and trail open.
- Addressing two erosion issues west of Beavercreek Station.
- 2. Spring Lakes Shelter rehab: Metal roof is on and the stone work is finishing up.
- 3. <u>Indian Mound Reserve:</u> Cleared and leveled area between old house and Peterson Park.
- 4. Twin Towers Shelter Rehab: Metal roof is on. Stone work is scheduled.
- 5. Frank Seaman Shelter Rehab.: Metal roof is on. Stone work is scheduled.
- 6. Clifton Lodge: Metal roof is on.
- 7. Xenia-Jamestown Connector: Addressing culvert issue west of Hogeye Rd.
- 8. Just completed an evaluation of all Bike Trails:
  - LMST will be crack filled and seal coated this year as part of our long-term care program.
  - Working on correcting the root pops on trials.

Mr. Dobney reported Pancakes in the Park at Russ March 7<sup>th</sup> 830am was huge success, near 600 people in attendance.
