## **Xenia Township Grant Request**

Mr. Dobney reported that non-profit organization Xenia Township Fire and Community Association has requested a Grant to assist in the purchasing a new Kubota ATV "ambulance" for the Fire Department to get them into places a regular Ambulance cannot get to.

#### Russ Nature Reserve

- Received settlement checks for all insurance claims except the tree portion.
- Met with two-tree arborist about the Russ House tree.
- Planning public playscape rebuild date.
- Preparing to demo the house.

#### 2. Pearl's Fen:

- Received approval to purchase Baker property from OPWC.
- Met with contractor to build boardwalk and two bridges for trails.
- Preparing to issue contract for land restoration work.

### 3. Caesar Ford:

- Update meeting on the Feasibility Study set for Oct 10th.
- Installed three bridges for multi-purpose trails
- Disc Golf tee pads are in.

## 4. Karohl Barn Review:

- Met members of the Hohl family on site-see inside barn.
- Met with architects on a quote for plans to build a shelter.
- 5. Mill Bridge Canoe Launch Grant: Cleared brush and debris along river and prepared three sites for covered picnic table to go in.
- 6. New Building: The building is completely dried in. Dry wall is going up. Stone on exterior going up...
- 7. CST: Preparing to bid deck replacement on the James Ranch Spur Bridge.
- 8. OET: MVRPC STP Grant for SFY 2021-2022. Submitting application for resurfacing OET. Max grant \$500,000.00. Total estimated cost \$1.2 M
- 9. Hobson: The remaining fitness equipment is in along with the fitness track.
