Alex Bieri, Chris Mucher, and Brian Housh presented to the Board their 3-phase plan to develop an off road/protected multi-use trail, that is family friendly and connects the Little Miami Scenic Trail in Yellow Springs to the Clifton Gorge parking lot. They are requesting \$300,000 to begin the project. No decisions have been made as of yet.

Additional Business:

Special Projects Manager Charles Frazier updated the Board on the current special projects within the park system.

- 1. Koogler Property Purchase:
 - Farm Field restoration to start soon. Part of Clean Ohio Grant.
- 2. Spotted Turtle Trail Update:
 - Our crew cleared out brush around parking lot and trail head.
 - The foundation for the new Trail Head sign has been poured.
- 3. Paving: We will be using the County Engineers' paving contract to pave the following.
 - Narrows repair parking lot
 - Jacoby Rd Launch
 - Clifton Lodge
 - Koogler Reserve
 - Phillips Park
 - Hobson Park
 - Twin Towers
- 4. Bike Path Xenia-Jamestown Connector:
 - Bridge abutment repairs
 - Tree removal

All bike paths

- Working with Superior Sealcoating on repairs of over 82 root pops on multiple trails.
- 5. Karohl Park: Playground is being installed.
- 6. Narrows: Replacing the steps on the Steep Trial between River Trail and Vista Trail.
- 7. <u>Indian Mound Reserve:</u> Working with Roger Williamson on a drainage issue at the border of our two properties.
