- 2. <u>Karohl Park:</u> CXT restroom is in production. We are preparing to do the soil testing and start the permitting process.
- 3. <u>Hobson Freedom Park:</u> CXT restroom is in production. We are preparing to do the soil testing and start the permitting process.
- 4. <u>725 Park Project:</u> State Representative Brian Lampton requested we submit an application for State Capital funds for the project.
- 5. <u>Russ Nature Reserve:</u> Engineers Without Boarders, a group with Wrights State University Engineering class, are finishing a project designing an observation deck that will over look the prairie at Russ Nature Reserve.
- 6. We are working on updating trail maps foreach individual park.
