Grant Request – Little Miami Conservancy:

Mr. Dobney discussed a grant request by the Little Miami Conservancy for the restoration of Hanshaw Wetland Nature Preserve. Restoration would include removal of non-native invasive species, removal of tires, metal, litter etc. and removal of abandoned structures. Upon the completion of this restoration project, the property would be open for public use. LMC has requested a grant to support the Phase I cost of this project. Mr. Dobney proposed a grant amount of \$5,000.
