1. Caesar Ford Campground:

- The CXT restroom/showers is in.
- Electric system is in the final stage. They may turn on this week.
- The remaining concrete work will wrap up this week and move into paving and seeding.
- 2. McCalmont Park: The parking lot is completed. Staff will work on a trail system and plan to open and cut a ribbon this fall.
- 3. Entrance Signs: Signs that have been completed are: Fairgrounds Recreation Center main entrance sign, Jacoby, Old Town and Sara Lee Arnovitz.
- 4. James Ranch Pond: The pond area has been leveled and graded to match the surrounding area.
- 5. Paving: Russ Will start late in the week of Sept. 4th. FGRC - Will start Sept. 11th.
- 6. Koogler: Scout Project was completed over the weekend. Gravel was put on the trails.
- 7. Hobson Trebein Rd. Crossing: The signals are in, the ADA approaches are complete and the road markings are coming soon. We are installing a bridge or culvert pipe to connect into the park.
