  - Possible soft opening in the Fall to work out snags, etc.

- 3. Entrance Signs: Pierce Park is completed with several others coming soon.
- 4. <u>James Ranch Pond:</u> We have added additional soil to aid in covering up the rocks left from the leveling. The area has been seeded.
- 5. Paving:
