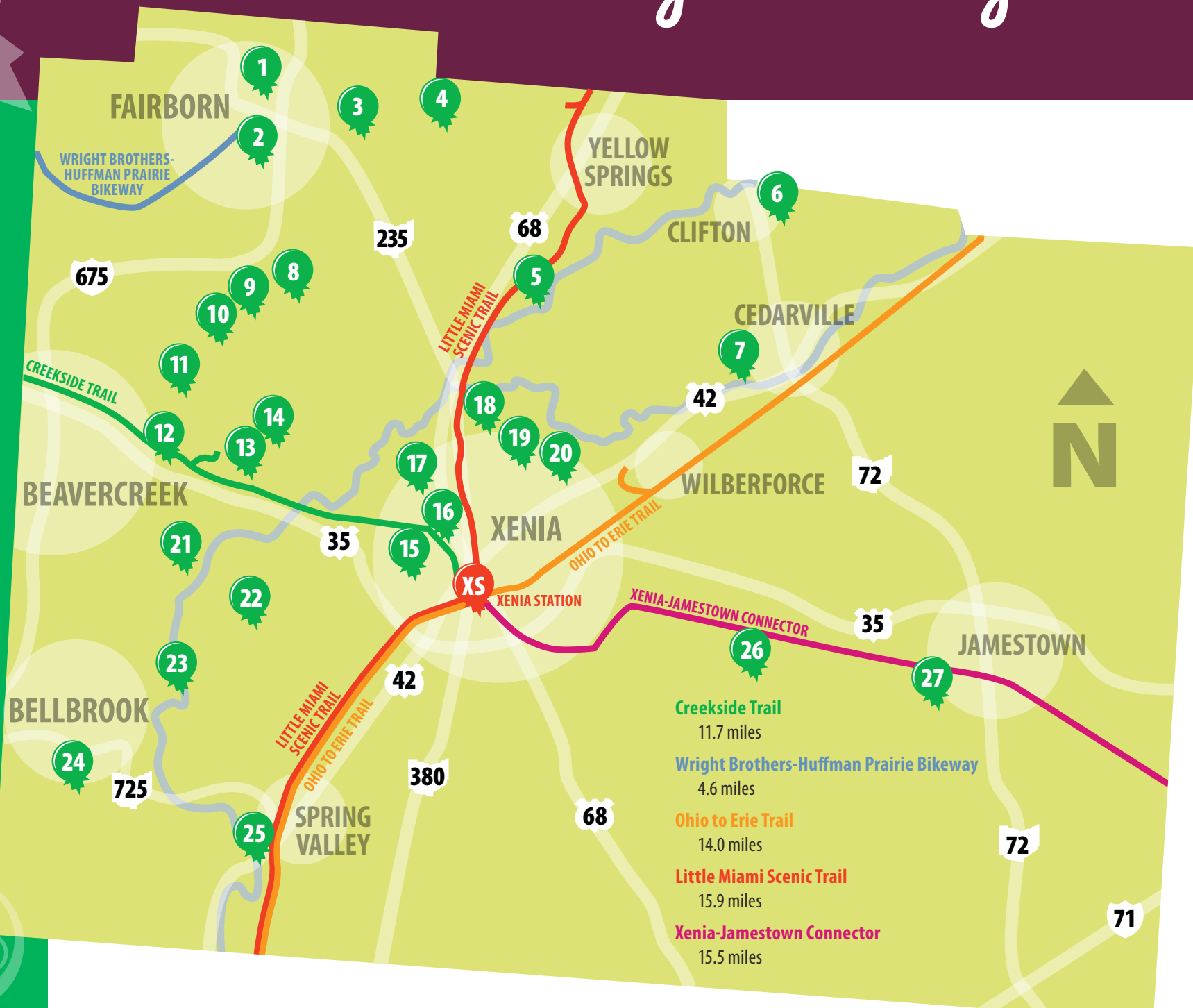

## BIKE TRAILS GALORE!

Xenia Station, just south of downtown Xenia, serves as the hub for Greene County's bike trails and links you to the nation's largest paved trail network. Across six counties, you can ride more than 350 miles of beautifully maintained paved trails.





### Beaver Creek Wetlands Reserve 14

76 acres – access via Phillips Park, Dayton-Xenia Rd., Beavercreek  
Fishing with state license, observation deck, hiking and birding.

### Caesar Ford Park 26

234 acres – 520 S. Stringtown Rd., Xenia  
Amphitheater, camping, Blue Jacket Room, shelter, picnic area, disc golf, horse trails, mountain biking, fishing with state license, hiking, birding, access to Xenia-Jamestown connector, restrooms and handicap access.

### Cemex Reserve 2

164 acres – 1100 Sanctuary Dr., Fairborn  
Hiking and birding.

### Clifton Reserve & Lodge 6

10 acres – 2762 S. River Rd., Clifton  
Fishing with state license, lodge, birding, picnic area and handicap access. Lodge must be reserved.

### Constitution Park 25

4 acres – St. Rt. 42 and St. Rt. 725, Spring Valley  
Canoe access, fishing with state license, picnic area, primitive camping with permit and handicap accessible.

### Creekside Reserve 12

137 acres – S.R. 35 between Factory Rd. & N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek  
Fishing with state license, hiking and birding. Accessible by Creekside Trail.

### Fairgrounds Recreation Center 17

71 acres – 210 Fairground Rd, Xenia  
Basketball, soccer, drinking water, picnic area, playground, seasonal restrooms, shelters, horseshoes, tennis courts, pickleball, handicap access and paved trail to Little Miami Scenic Trail and Creekside Reserve.

### Frank Seaman Park 27

40 acres – 4730 Cottonville Rd., Jamestown  
Baseball/softball fields, soccer, drinking water, picnic area, playground, seasonal restrooms, shelter, tennis courts, handicap access and access to the Xenia-Jamestown connector.

### Hebble Creek Reserve 1

78 acres – Spangler Road, Fairborn  
Birding.



### Hobson Freedom Park 8

92 acres – 2910 Trebein Rd., Fairborn  
Soccer (reservation only), shelter, picnic area, playground and fitness trail.



### Indian Mound Reserve 7

169 acres – 2750 US Rt. 42 E., Cedarville  
Fishing with a state license, hiking, shelter, restrooms, picnic area, historical Williamson Indian Mound, log home, waterfall, scenic views, wildflowers and photography.

### Jacoby Road Canoe Launch 5

22 acres – 669 Jacoby Rd., Xenia  
Canoe access, fishing with a state license, birding, picnic area and primitive camping with permit.

### James Ranch Park 16

4 acres – 177 Fairground Rd., Xenia  
Access to Creekside Trail, fishing with a state license, picnic area, gazebo, 1800's farmhouse, display gardens and handicap access.

### Karohl Park 11

29 acres – 2940 Hohl Rd., Beavercreek  
Disc golf and trails.

### Kinsey Road Mound 20

5 acres – 965 Mound Ct., Xenia  
Hiking and historical Adena Indian Mound.

### Koogler Wetland Prairie Reserve 9

48 acres – 2735 Beaver Valley Rd, Fairborn  
Boardwalk, hiking and birding.

### McCalmont Park 22

97 acres – 1940 Indian Ripple Road, Xenia  
Hiking trails, prairie.

### Mill Bridge Launch 23

11 acres – 2754 Graf Mill Rd., Bellbrook  
Canoe access, fishing with state license, hiking, primitive camping with permit and picnic area.



### Narrows Reserve and Nature Center 21

162 acres – 2575 Indian Ripple Rd., Beavercreek  
Canoe access, fishing with state license, raptor aviary, bee apiary, Critter Cove, hiking, birding, picnic area and primitive camping with permit.

### Old Town Reserve 18

7 acres – 1360 Old Springfield Pike, Xenia  
Access to the Little Miami Scenic Trail, shelter, picnic area, drinking water and primitive camping with permit.

### Pearl's Fen 3

15 acres – 4535 Byron Road, Fairborn  
Hiking, birding, wildflowers, boardwalk and access to Oakes Quarry connector.

### Phillips Park 13

34 acres – 2090 Dayton-Xenia Road, Beavercreek  
Fishing with state license, hiking, birding, shelter, picnic area and restrooms.

### Pierce Park 15

34 acres – 618 Dayton-Xenia Rd., Xenia  
Scout Dog Park, drinking water and shelter.

### Russ Nature Reserve 10

90 acres – 2380 Kemp Rd., Beavercreek  
Hiking, bee apiary, birding, restored prairie, Lovely Nature PlayScape, picnic area and demonstration gardens.

### Sara Lee Arnovitz Nature Preserve 19

43 acres – 350 Kinsey Rd., Xenia  
Hiking, birding, boardwalk and handicap access.

### Spring Lakes Park 24

23 acres – 2191 Ferry Rd., Bellbrook  
Fishing with a GCP&T permit, birding, picnic area, shelter and restrooms.

### Twin Towers Park 4

102 acres – 501 Yellow Springs-Fairfield Rd., Bath Twp.  
Horse facilities, glider field, birding, picnic area, shelter, restrooms and handicap access.
